

#### **Boat Monitors**

The Boat monitors are in full swing. Don Easter is a familiar face, once again running the show. Thank you Don! Kathy Wirthwein has just arrived, plus, our college girls are on the job. Holly Greenleaf, Kyle Berge and Natalie Raeder are occupying Don with their crazy concert schedules, and we have a new employee Ashlee Bisson. Her parents are new residents on the lake and she will be a senior at St. Johnsbury Academy.

## Notable & Newsworthy | Karla Cornelius

Last year at our annual meeting we voted to contribute \$5000 to the Town of Barnet toward the cost of a new gate for our dam, to better control our lake level and water quality. Select Board chair Ted Faris reports the gate is on order and we are close to installation of Phase I.

As to our (non) internet service: In 2009 over 100 people signed our petition for internet service, gladly committing to be a customer of just about any provider, as long as they would provide. Despite all our efforts, we are still waiting. Vermont Telephone (VTel) has received federal funding to implement a wireless broadband network (WOW) in 14 rural Vermont telephone exchanges, including ours. It is to be complete late 2013. Go to Vermontel.com to track its progress. Northern Community Investment Corporation (NCIC) is further along with a bandwidth tower to be installed shortly on Garland Hill. However the permitted secondary tower serving the lake is on hold until issues yet remaining are resolved. Their website is ncic. org. In the interim, Hughes Net satellite service is available for a (substantial) fee/commitment.

Take action - email **consumer@state.vt.us** and call **800-622-4496** on an ongoing basis, HOUND them to make something happen as soon as possible. This is so important, especially to those many of us still working here at the lake.

Regarding our LHA website: So much time went into creating it, but involvement remains sporadic. Our classified section and gift shop will be posted soon, and Dick Downer is working on our map of lake properties. He has many other wonderful ideas for our site, but we need help! Volunteers would be great. Our blog is available to our Board, and to all members who request their password via email to lakeharveyassociation@lakeharvey.com. Bloggers would also be great!

Finally, don't forget to give. The Town has been generous again this year, but we still need so much more to sustain our monitoring program full bore. Prevention is our best solution. And LHA bears the full cost of our firework display, that very special evening we all so enjoy every year. So contribute – it's tax deductible!


