Lake Harvey Association Winter Letter

January 2025 Dear Members of the Association,

As I write this the deep freeze has returned to the lake and icehouses and ice fishermen are scattered across the lake. The loons and ducks are gone but the eagles still swoop low looking for prey. The days have started to lengthen again so thoughts do turn to the coming summer. The Town of Barnet has signed contracts to repair the beach before July. We hope that we will be able to use it for the fireworks display as there are no other suitable areas around the lake. The fireworks company has allowed us to roll over the funds we paid for the cancelled display last year to this year. Harvey's Lake weekend will be July 19-20 this year. Details of events will be sent out in the spring.

The lake association board approved a petition to the state to restrict the use of wake sport mode on boats on the lake due to the large and disruptive waves created. The boats themselves would be allowed on the lake but the use of ballast or wake enhancing devices would not. The petition is being presented to the town selectboard before it is sent to the state. A number of other lakes our size have petitioned the state for similar restrictions.
